- Dialogue & Cohesion: Art serves as a bridge for discussion, collaboration, and community solidarity.





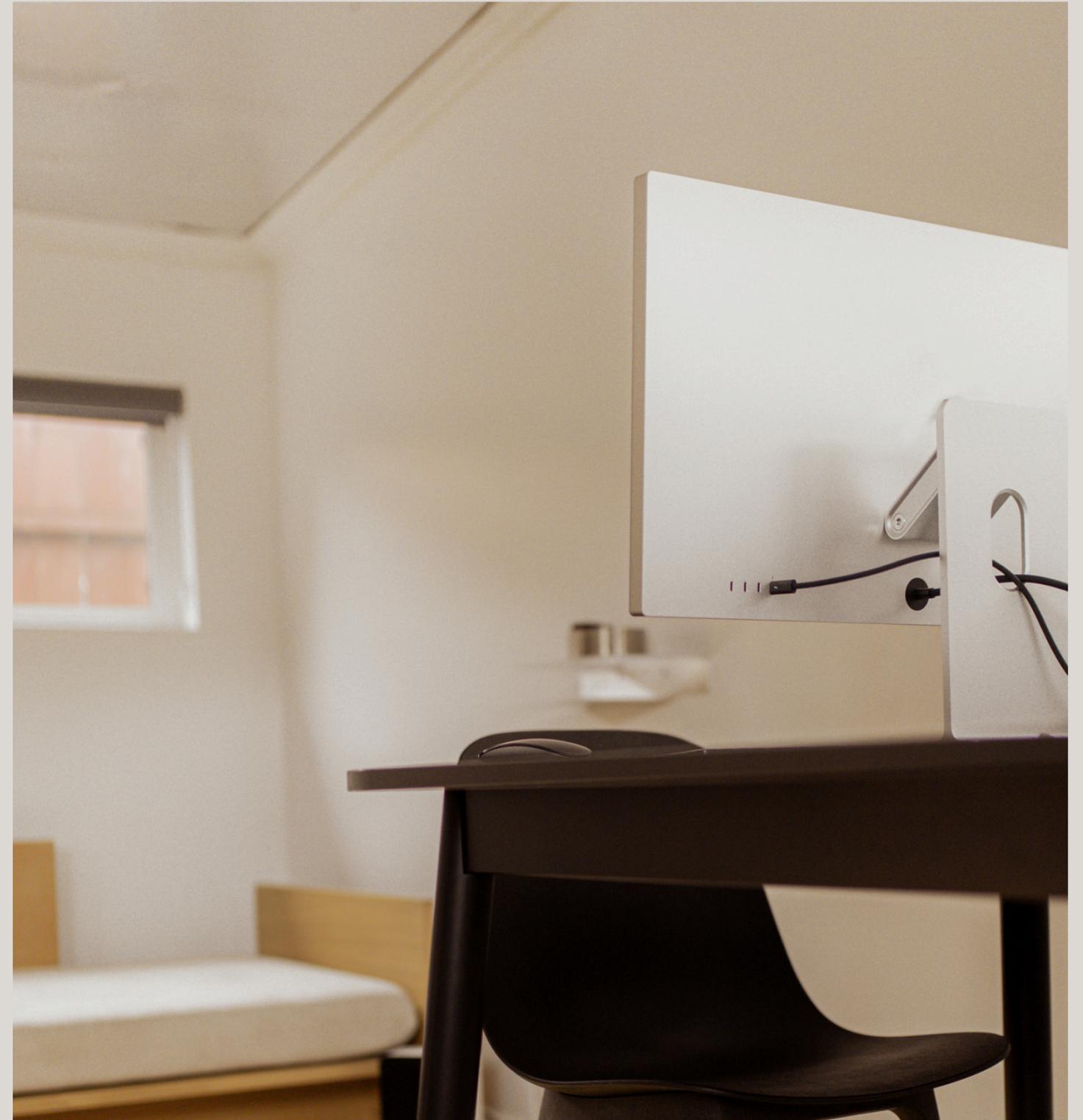
# ARTY Project: Expected Impact

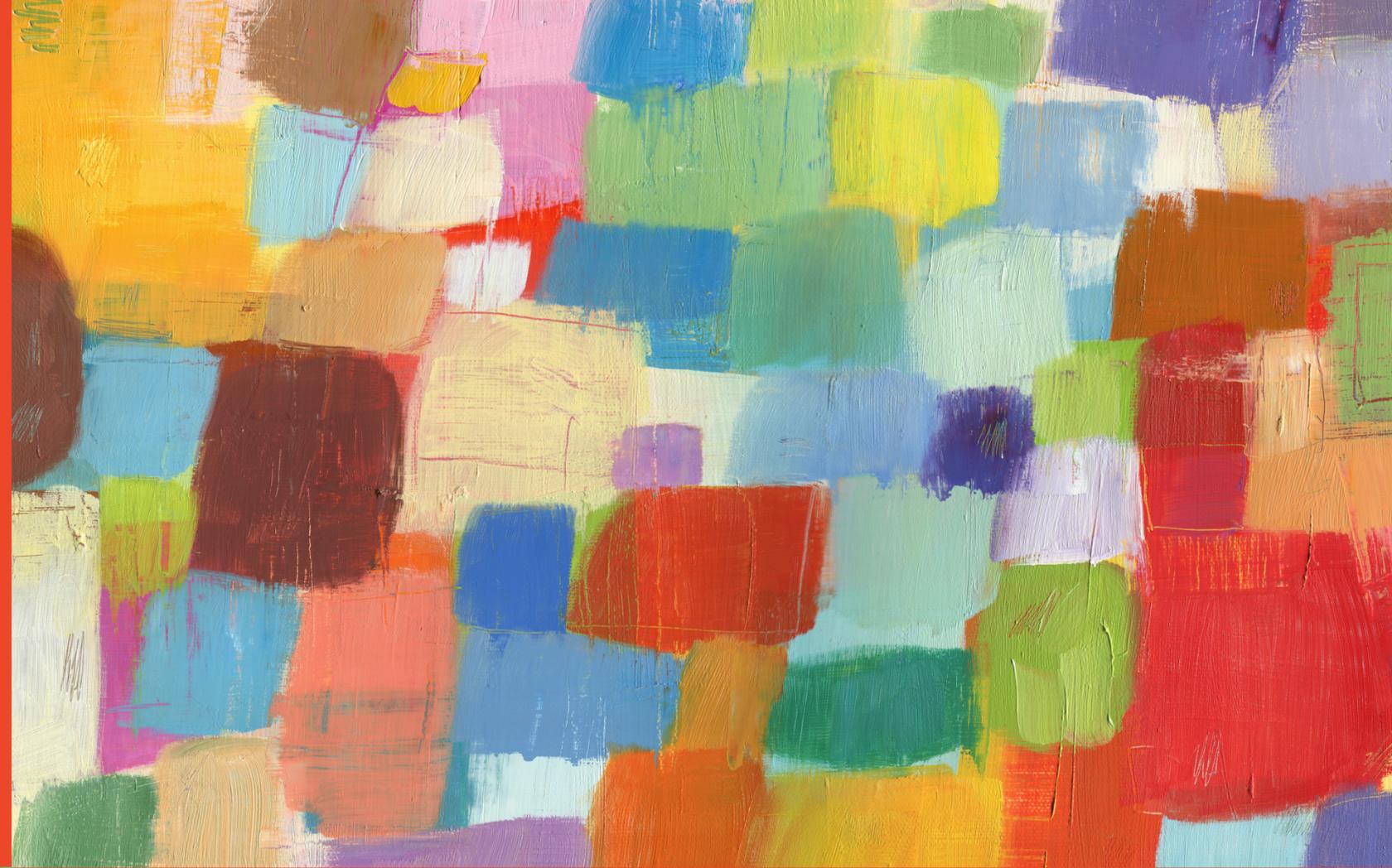

# ↳ Principles of Youth Engagement

## -Collaboration & Teamwork:

Promote cooperation between peers, mentors, and local communities.

Encourage dialogue, shared problem-solving, and creative partnerships.

## -Reflection & Learning:

Support continuous personal and professional growth through feedback and reflection.

Facilitate understanding of social, cultural, and artistic contexts.

## -Sustainability & Long-Term Engagement:

Build habits and networks that encourage ongoing participation in arts and civic activities.

Inspire youth to continue creative engagement beyond the project timeline.



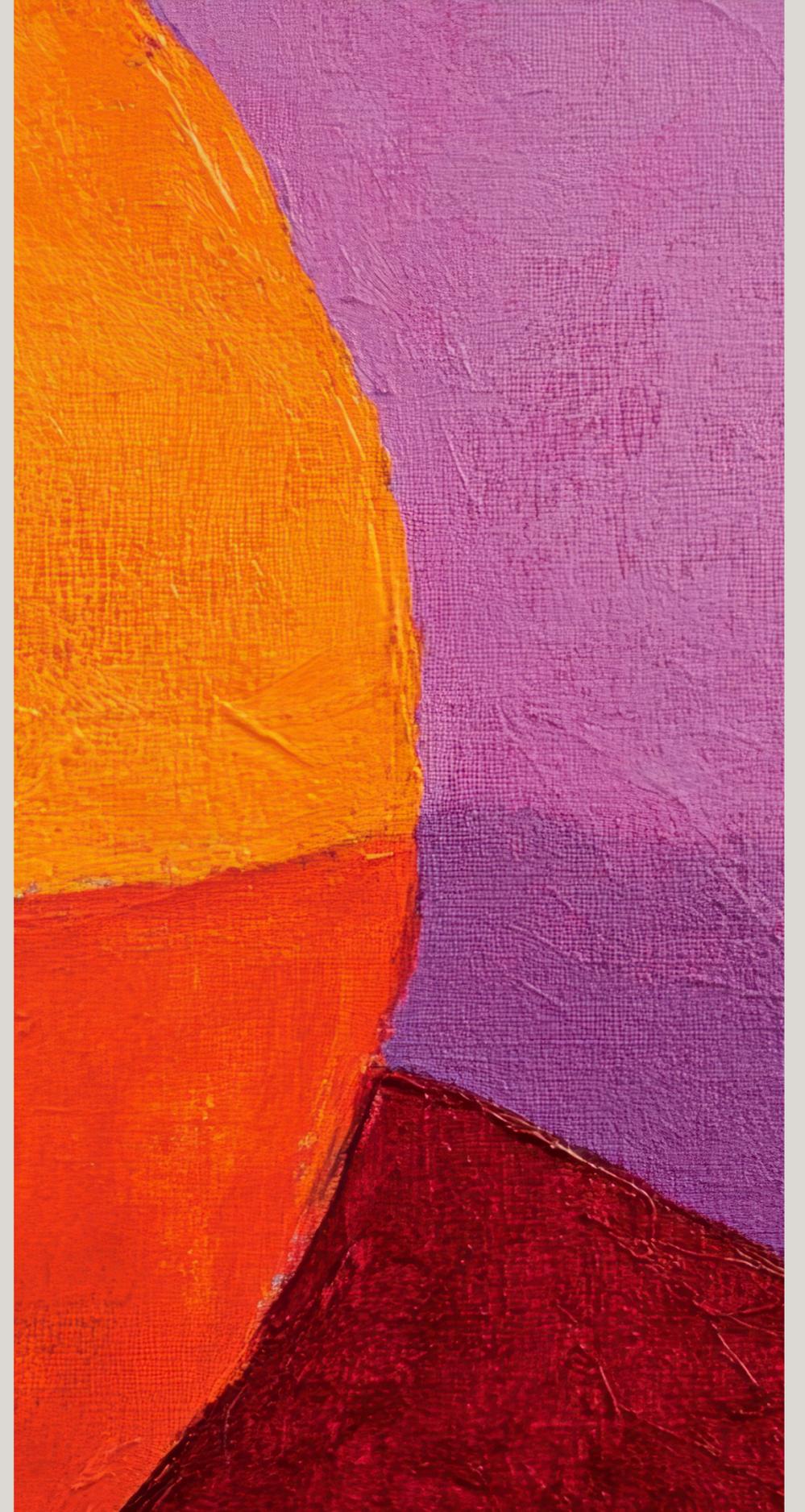


# Event Preparation Phase

- Strategic Planning:
  - Define event structure, schedule, and key milestones for the 3-day celebration.
  - Align all activities with project goals and learning outcomes.
- Stakeholder Coordination:
  - Collaborate with partner organizations, local authorities, and community institutions.
  - Assign roles and responsibilities for smooth execution.
- Venue & Logistics:
  - Secure an accessible, welcoming location in Kastoria suitable for exhibitions, workshops, and ceremonies.
  - Plan transportation, accommodation, technical equipment, and safety measures.
- Artworks & Exhibits:
  - Collect, curate, and prepare artworks from all previous project activities.
  - Ensure proper framing, labeling, and display for public appreciation.
- Promotion & Communication:
  - Develop a communication strategy to inform participants, local media, and the community.
  - Use social media, newsletters, and local networks to maximize attendance and engagement.
- Materials & Resources:
  - Prepare certificates, informational leaflets, and interactive materials.
  - Ensure availability of workshop supplies, technology, and presentation tools.

# ↳ Event Implementation Phase

- Exhibition & Showcase:
- Present all collected artworks from project participants.
- Organize guided tours, artist statements, and interactive explanations for visitors.
- Engagement & Networking:
- Facilitate dialogue among youth, project partners, local authorities, and community members.
- Encourage cross-cultural collaboration and exchange of ideas.
- Special Ceremonies:
- Host official opening and closing ceremonies.
- Award certificates of participation, recognition, and highlight exceptional contributions.
- Community Involvement:
- Invite local residents, schools, and institutions to participate.

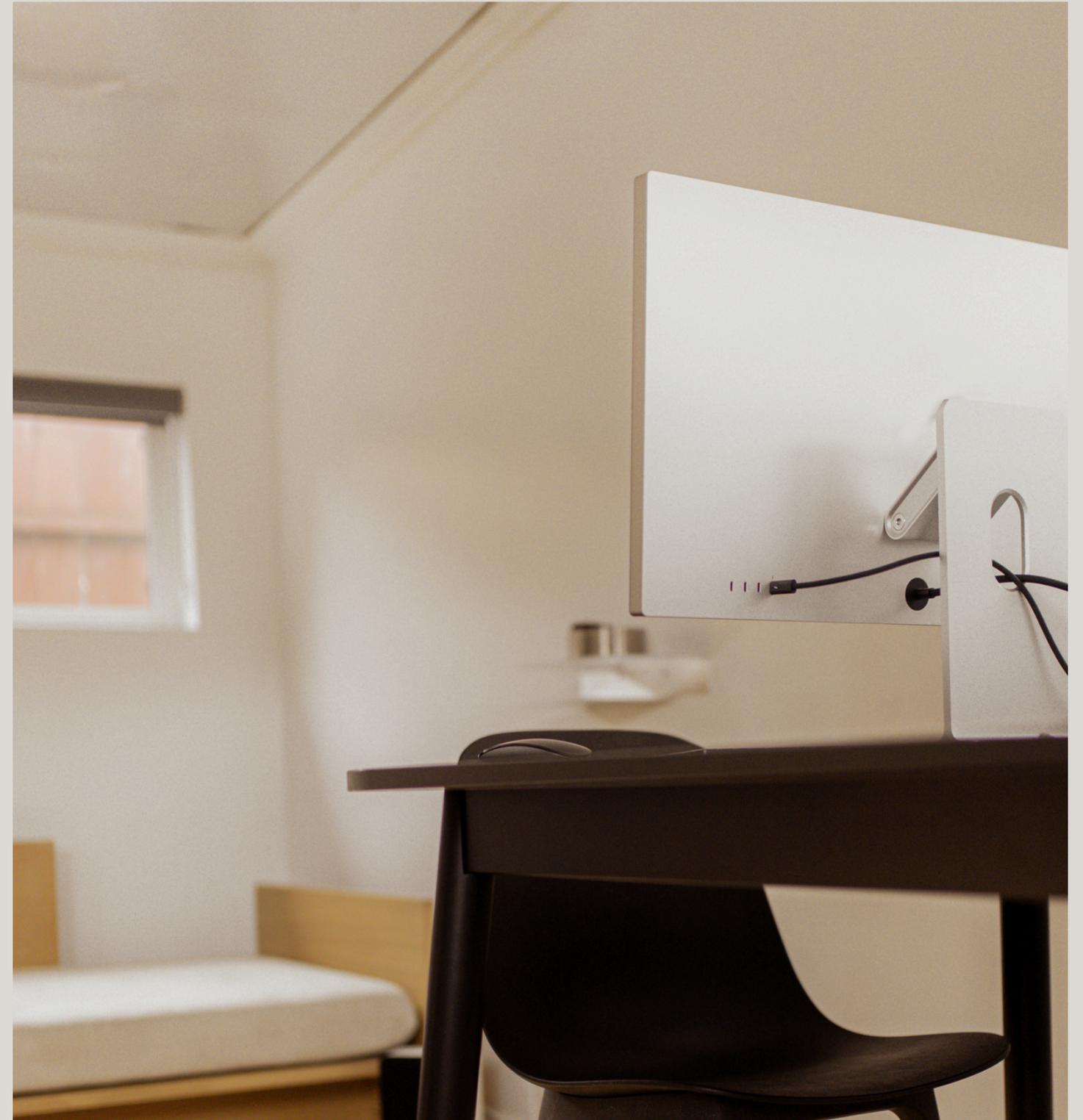
